## “ANYAMAN TIKAR”

### ANYAMAN

Tikar is a Malaysian universal craft art that has existed for the past 300 years. It is believed that handicraft art appears and develops without external influence. because the pattern and the carcass have no outside element. The wickerwork is done by women to fill their spare time and not the main quest.

### HANDCRAFT

as tools for their own use or as gifts to relatives or friends. Woven activities are usually carried out by women, men only help to print and process their leaves. Basic skills in woven art are not much different, just depend on the kind of plants made of woven material.

### JUNGLE

products such as bamboo, rattan, pandanus, kuang and thousands contribute to the main result of woven handicraft. The wickerwork of the jungle is like daily items, decorations, and gifts. The results show the unique and the art and the creativity of Malaysian society.

carpentry organized by the State museum.**

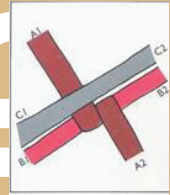
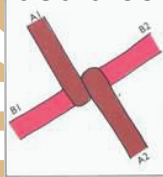

## “ANYAMAN TIKAR”

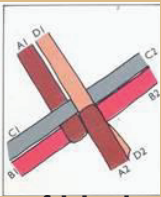


01 Leaves are laid beating each other

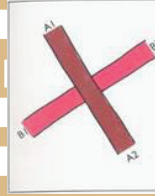
02 Blade ends (A2) folded around



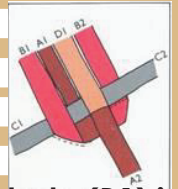
03 New leaf blade plus (C)



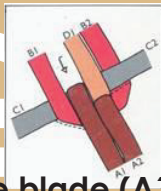
04 New leaf blade added (D) and some overlap with blade (A)



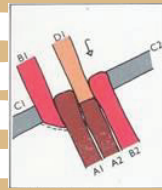
05 Bar (B2) folded upwards through the back blade (C1-C2)



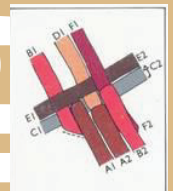
06 The blade (B1) is folded upwards



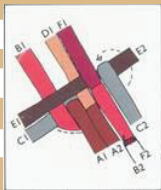
07 The blade (A1) is folded down
